

# Esther Short Streetscape

Esther Street is a downtown collector with a modern roundabout at the intersection of 6th Street and Esther Street.

This Gateway project is part of the redevelopment of historic downtown Vancouver.

The project was designed as a curbless pedestrian plaza with creative traffic delineation. 6th Street was designed to transmit surfacing patterns from the park without compromising traffic capacity.



Improvements were planned to provide water, power and data services for Vancouver's Farmers Market. The roundabout featured streetscape and low maintenance landscape elements which set the design tone of future redevelopment to the west and south of Esther Short Park.
