The Vancouver Conference Center and Hilton Hotel building is located in downtown historic Vancouver. HDJ worked with the City of Vancouver from the planning stages on this unique project. The Center has become the cornerstone example for

new streetscape expectations as part of the Esther Short Streetscape Improvements plan.

As the first LEED certified hotel in the United States, the Center has been recognized in many national magazines as setting the precedent for Green Design.

HDJ offered civil engineering design, utility and street improvements, project management and traffic signal design to serve the over 2-acre site. The Conference Center is over 30,000-square feet in size, and the four-star Hotel houses a Grand Ballroom and Junior Ballroom, as well as 226 guest rooms.
